Complete this form if you are opposed to borrowing an amount not to exceed two million dollars to purchase land and construct and equip a third fire hall in the South Shawnigan area in the Shawnigan Improvement District.

Complete a new form for each eligible Shawnigan Improvement District voter wishing to oppose the proposal.

This form must be received by first class mail within the time period ending February 20, 2012, to Shawnigan Improvement District, P.O. Box 3, Shawnigan Lake, BC V0R 2W0.

### VOTER ELIGIBILITY:

Persons entitled to VOTE must meet all of the following qualifications:

- 1) is a Canadian citizen
- 2) is 18 years of age or older
- 3) is an owner of land within the Shawnigan Improvement District
- 4) is a resident of the province for the prior six months

One vote is also allowed for each board or corporation that owns land within the improvement district. The board or corporation must designate one person to act as an authorized agent to vote on its behalf. This should be done in writing so the chair or returning officer can verify the vote.

If more than one person is registered on title as an owner of land, each one can vote as long as they also meet the other qualifications. However, no person can have two votes unless they meet the qualifications to be an elector and are also an agent authorized to vote on behalf of a board or corporation.
